This month I would like to share some of the happenings with PBIS that are taking place at Dakota Prairie.

- The district adopted PBIS which stands for positive behavior interventions and supports. It is an approach schools use to promote school safety and good behavior. Committees were trained over the summer in order to come back and share what they learned. The committee here consists of Alec Sogn, Josie Sauer, Tanna Stadler, Cory Davis, Sadie Elverud, Carleen Holm, and Sarah Weber.
- The elementary schools aligned expectations for all of the common areas (see image below). We did this to help learners and families as they move through our buildings.
- To introduce PBIS to our learners the staff made videos for each common area. First they recorded themselves breaking all of the expectations and then modeled all of the same behaviors in a safe and positive way. The learners have enjoyed watching these videos almost as much as the teachers did making them!
- After expectations were introduced everyone in the building was given a leaf to decorate and sign to show commitment to PBIS. They will be used to grow our Dakota Prairie Family Tree in the commons area (see images below). It is a great visual to remind us that we are all in this together and our promise to do our best to follow these expectations. We are still working on hanging them all up, so our tree will continue to grow!
