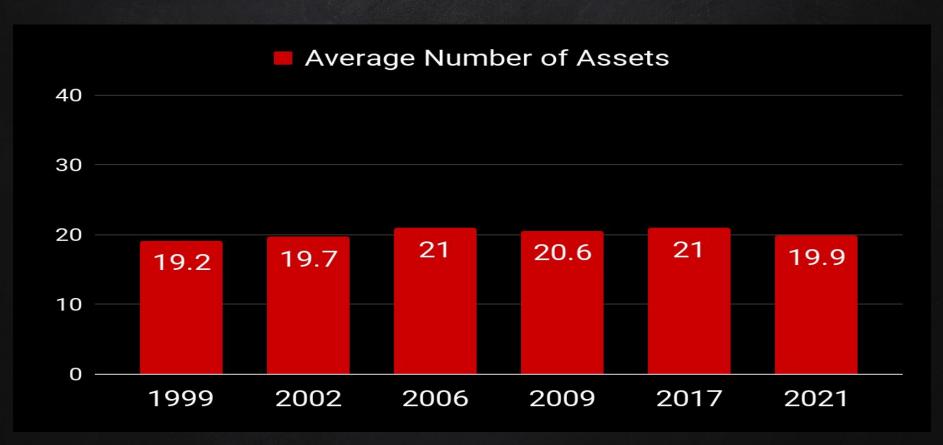

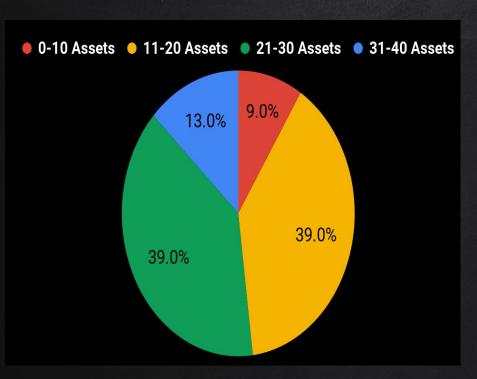

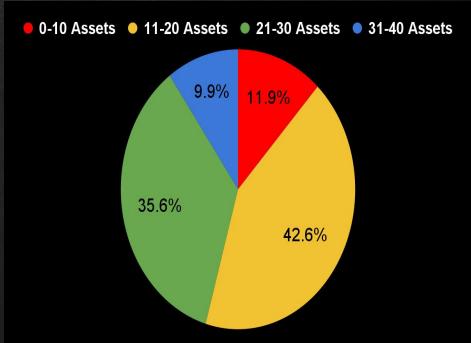

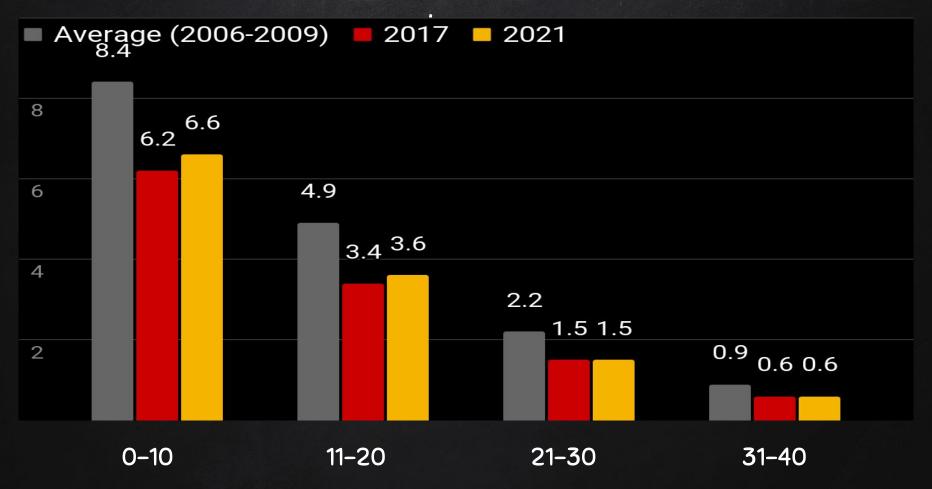

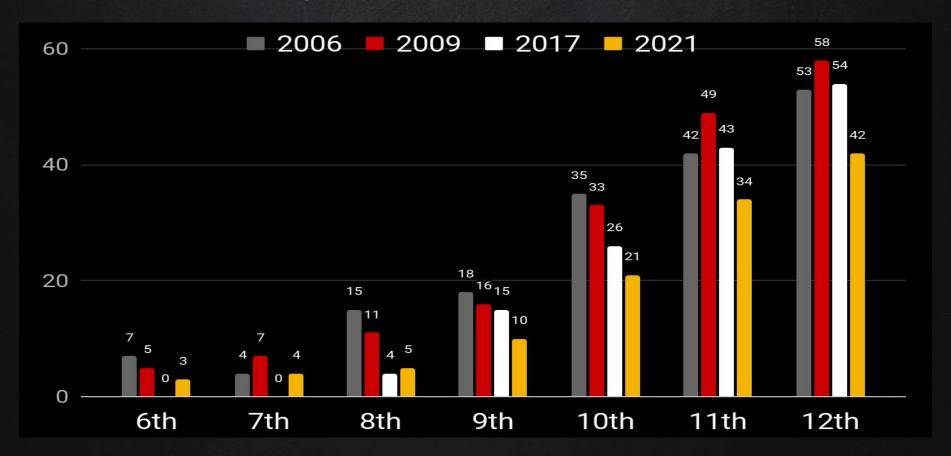
AVERAGE NUMBER OF THRIVING INDICATORS BY ASSET LEVEL



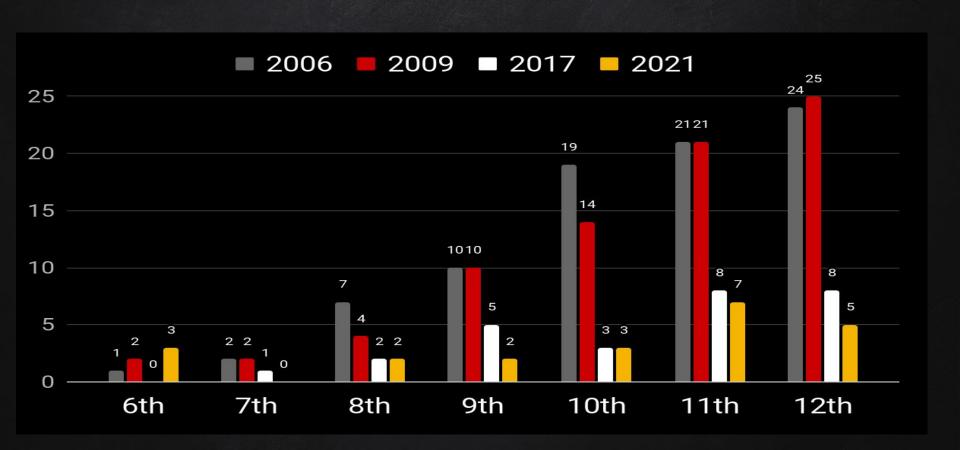
AVERAGE NUMBER OF THE 24 RISK TAKING BEHAVIORS BY ASSET



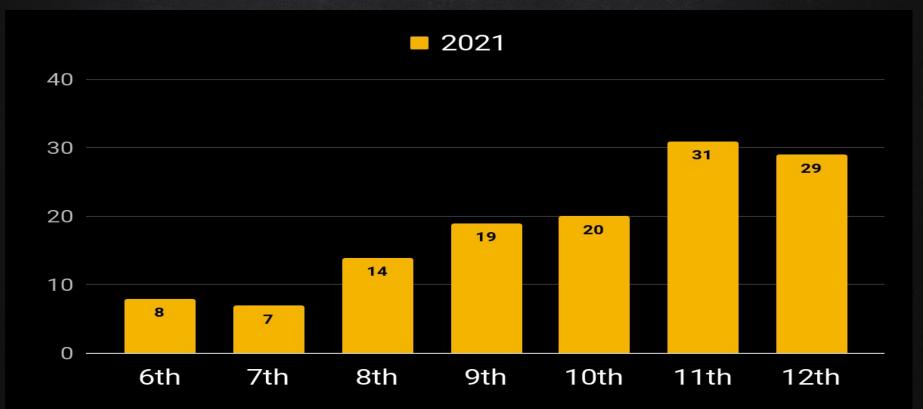

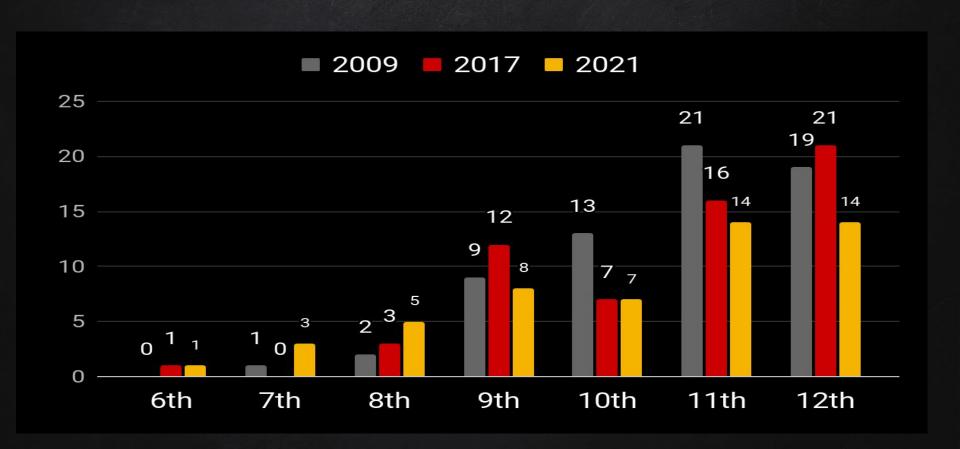

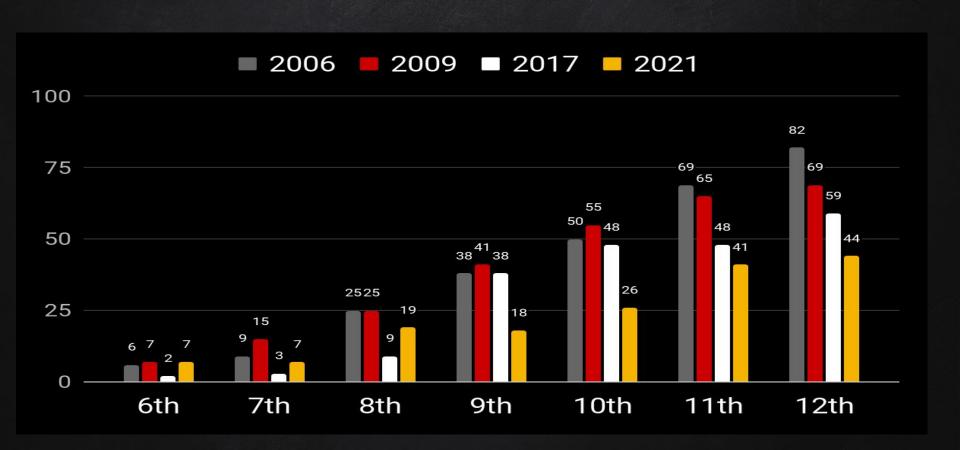
VAPED TOBACCO, NICOTINE, OR MARIJUANA IN LAST 30 DAYS



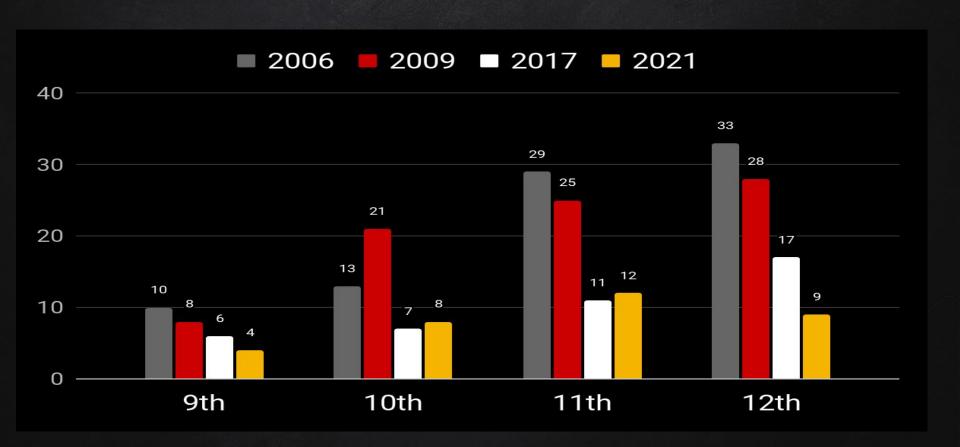

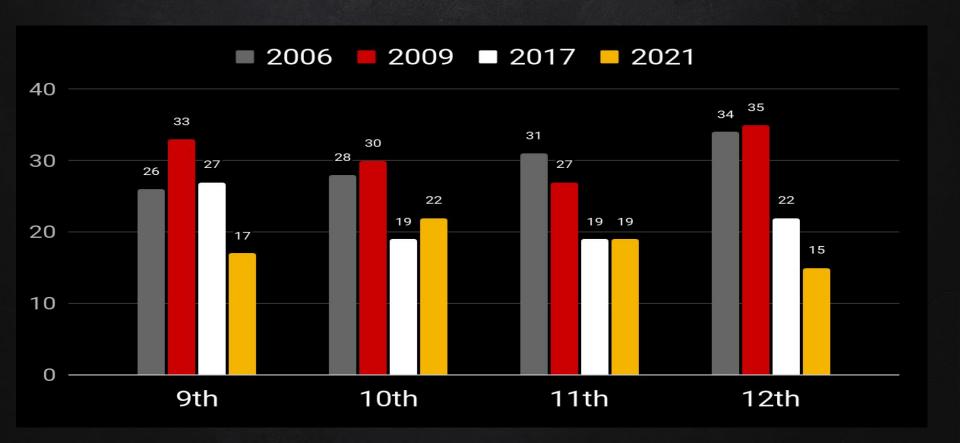

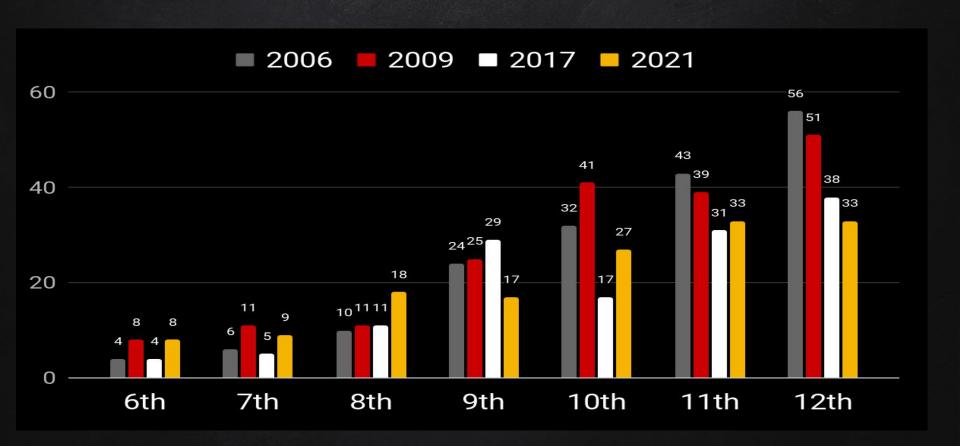
DRIVEN A CAR AFTER YOU HAD BEEN DRINKING



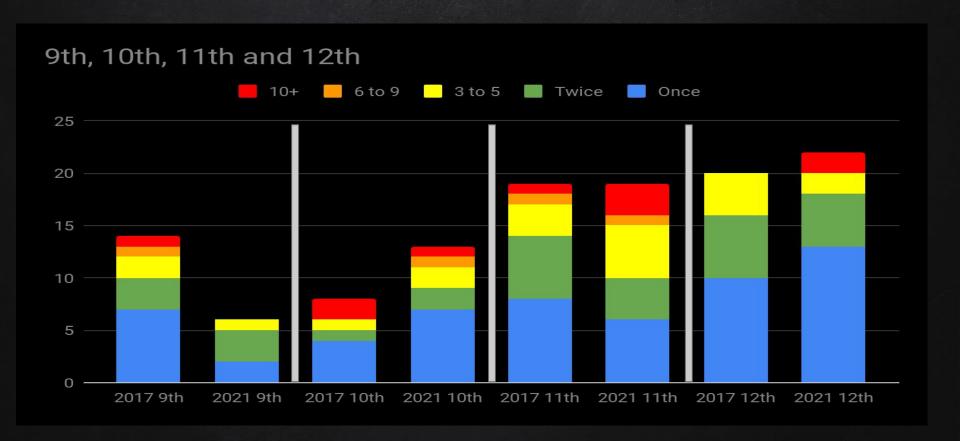

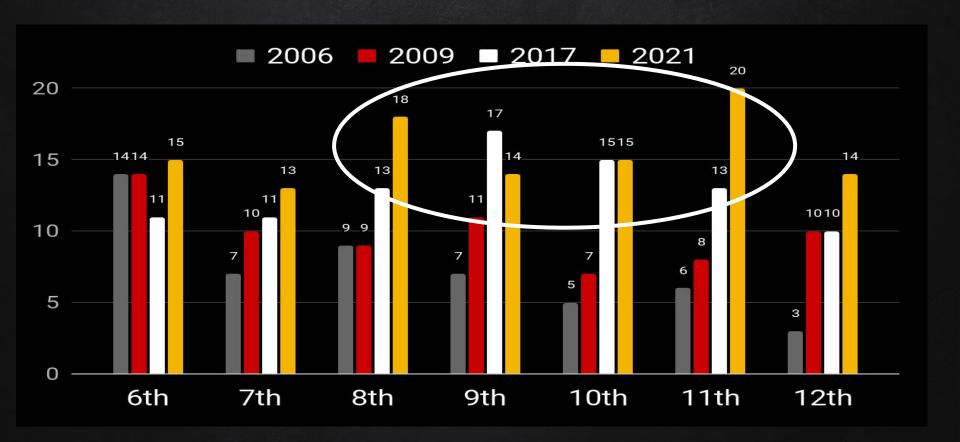

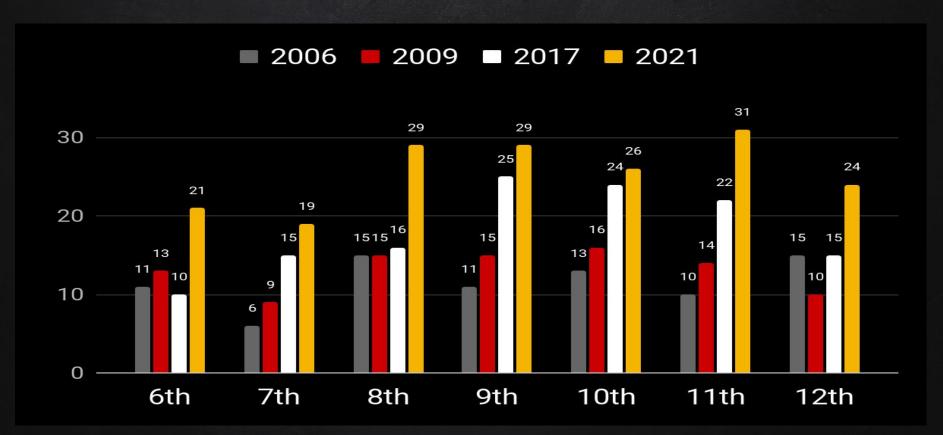
% WHO HAVE BINGE DRANK DURING THE LAST TWO WEEKS



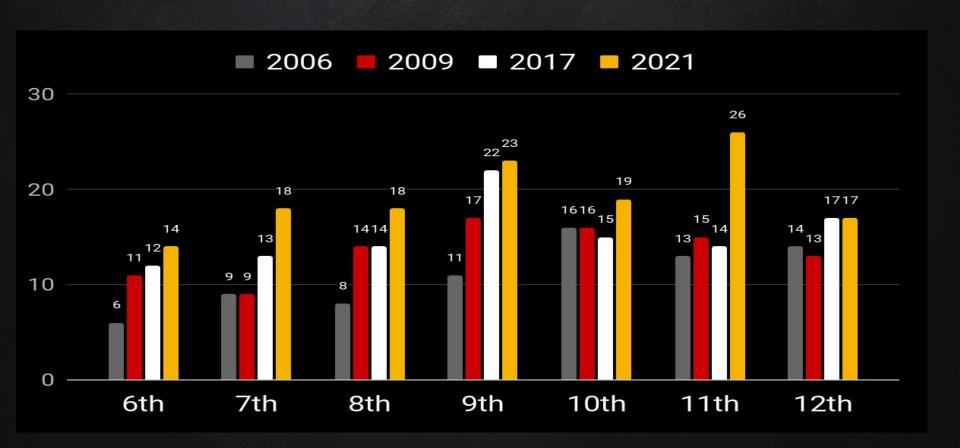

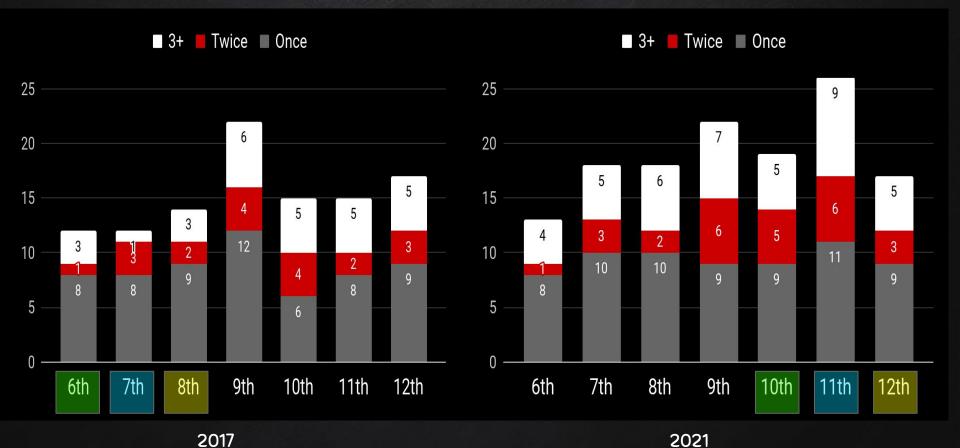

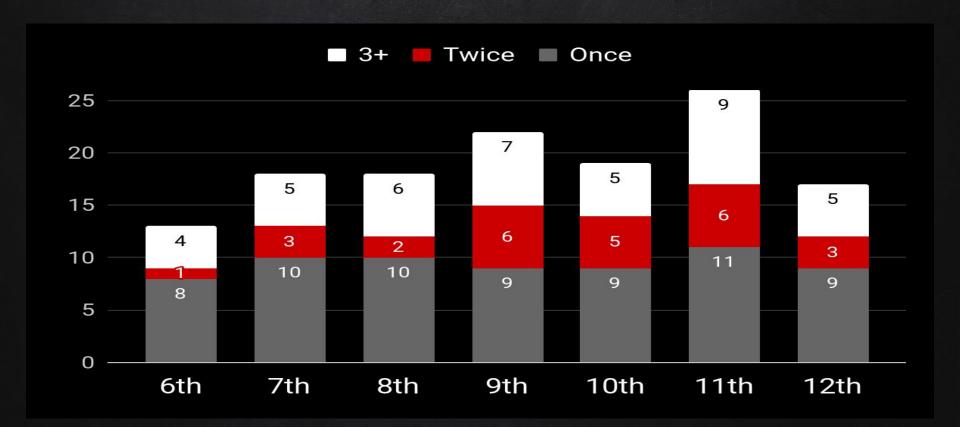

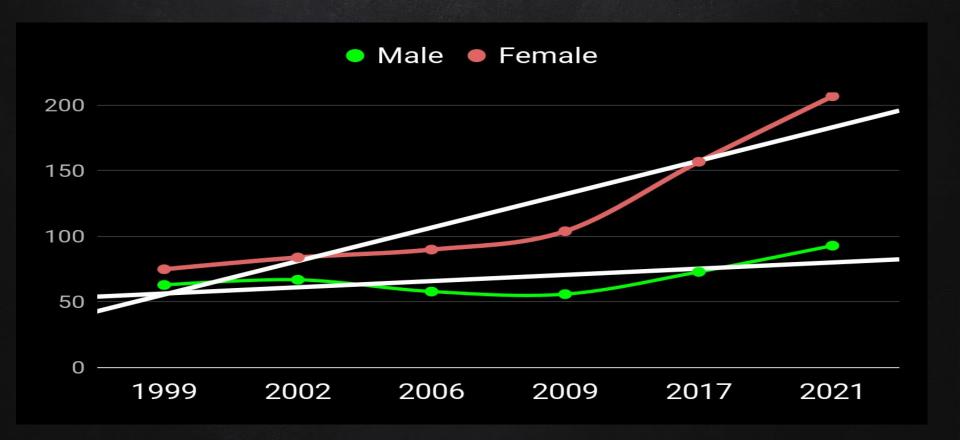

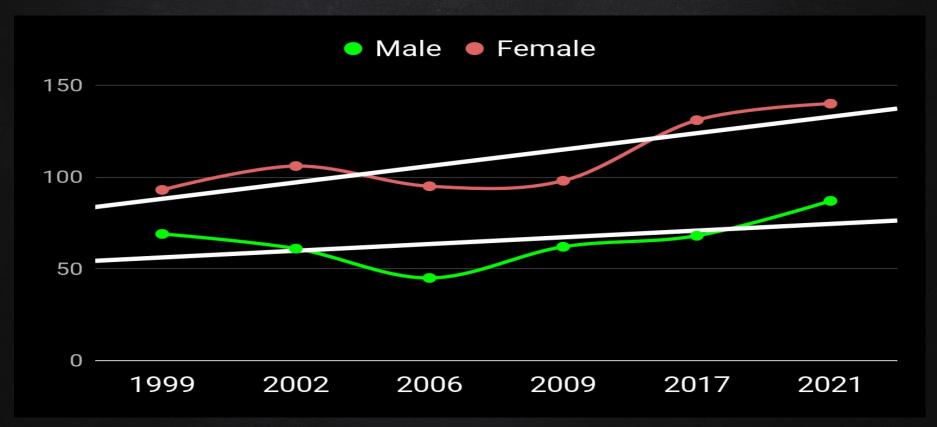
HAVE YOU EVER TRIED TO KILL YOURSELF? - 2021



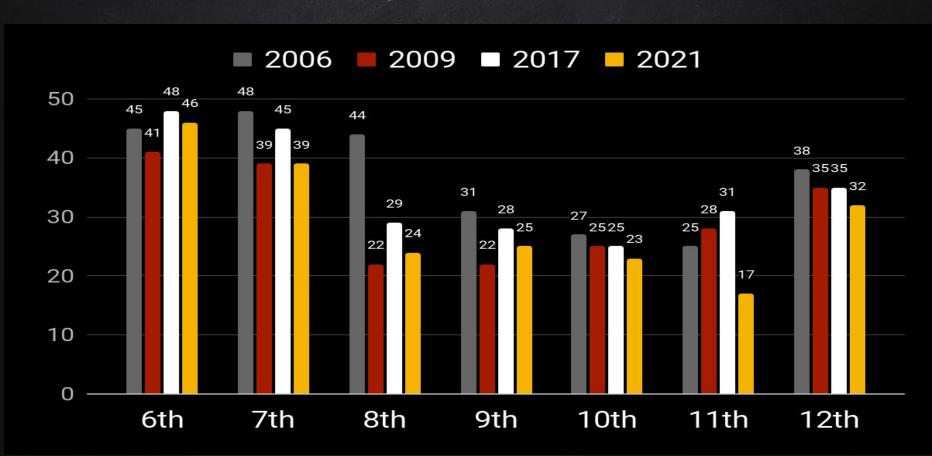
DEPRESSION - NUMBER OF MALES VS. FEMALES

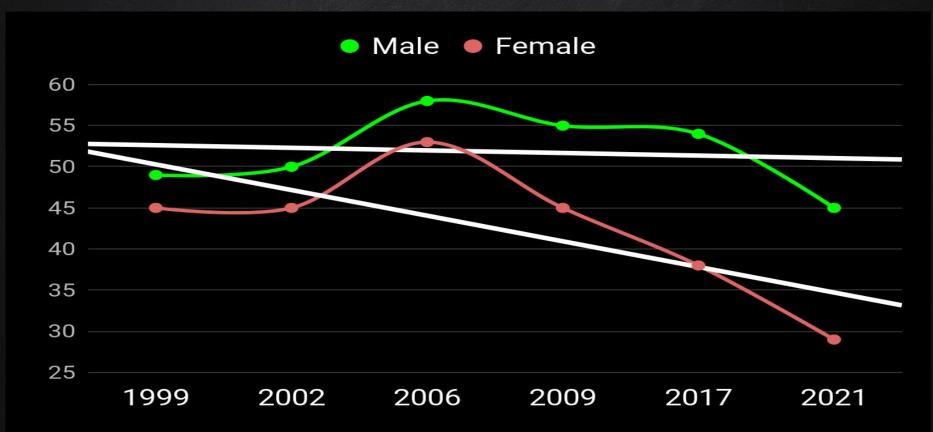

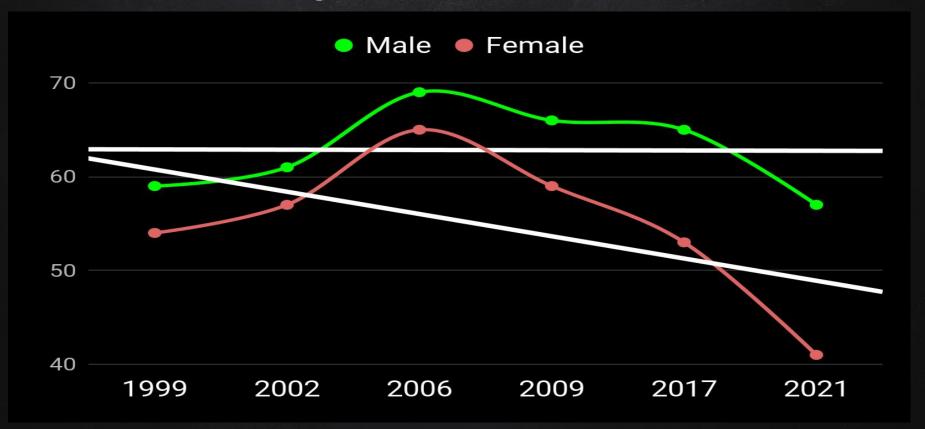

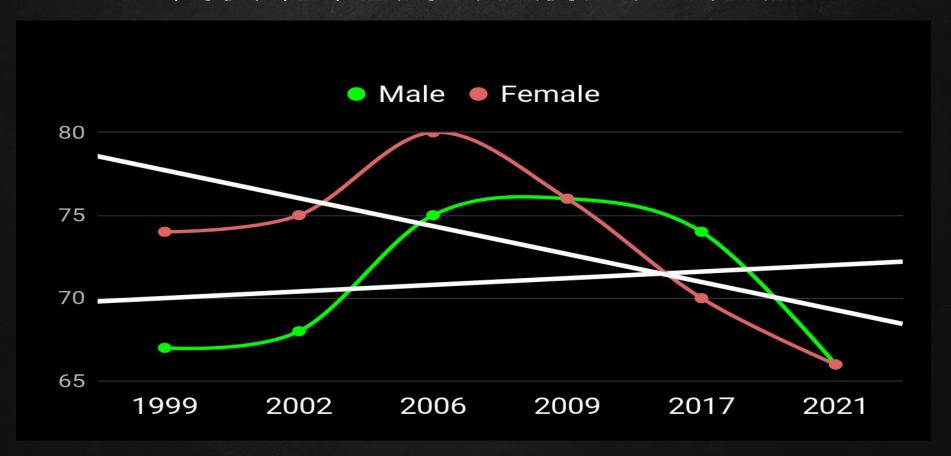
