A Great Place to Learn

- *Attendance Matters!*
Our first month of attendance we have had a strong start! Camelot hopes to have attendance consistently in the 90th percentile or higher for learner attendance. Our Camelot September Average was 96.1%
- *Band and Orchestra*
Our band and orchestra participation for this upcoming year is strong. Fourth-grade Orchestra has 135; Fifth Grade Orchestra has 112, and Fifth Grade band enrolled 151 musicians. All areas continue to grow as learners continue to sign up!
- *Science of Reading: Universal Screener – Acadience*
Our learners were screened during this first month of school using our universal screener, Acadience. Our benchmark assessments show that in fourth grade, 50% of learners are below the benchmark, and 50% are at or above the benchmark. In Fifth Grade, 64% of learners were below benchmark and 36% at or above benchmark.
