## LEARNER DIRECTORY INFORMATION NOTICE

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that the school dDistrict, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records. However, the dDistrict may disclose designated "directory information" without written consent, unless you have informed the dDistrict that prior written consent is required before disclosing the directory information. The primary purpose of directory information is to allow the dDistrict to include this type of information from your child's education records in certain school publications.

Directory information, which is information that is generally not considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released, can also be disclosed to outside organizations without a parent's, guardian's or eligible learner's prior written consent. Outside organizations include, but are not limited to, companies that manufacture class rings or publish yearbooks. In addition, federal and state laws require the district to provide military recruiters and institutions of higher education, upon request, with the names, addresses and telephone listings of the learner, and to provide the executive director of the SD Board of Regents and each technical college located in the state with the names and mailing addresses the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of the learners in grades 7-12. This information will be provided unless parents or guardians have completed Form JOA-E(1) which advises the district that they do not want their student's information disclosed without their prior written consent.

If you do not want the school dDistrict to disclose directory information from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must notify the District in writing within thirty (30) days of the beginning of the school year or, if enrolling after the beginning of the school year, within thirty (30) days of enrollment. The dDistrict has designated the following information as directory information: [Note: a district may, but does not have to, include all the information listed below.]
